The small house located at Via Bari 11 in Bolzano is one of the very few “case Semirurali” still standing today. In the 1930s, hundreds of these homes were built as a solution to the housing needs of the fast-growing working-class population. From the 1980s onwards, most of these homes were demolished in order to make space for high-density housing. The neighbourhood’s desire to preserve the memory of the “case Semirurali” led to the opening, in 2015, of an exhibition that explores the “case Semirurali” history through photographs, videos, maps, three-dimensional models and captivating stories about everyday life.
