REQUIREMENTS

Applicants who successfully passed the selection procedure are admitted through the ranking lists.

SELECTION CRITERIA

In order to gain admission to this programme candidates need one of the following qualifications:

- a) bachelor degree in computer science (L-31 Scienze e tecnologie informatiche) or information engineering (L-8 Ingegneria dell'informazione) obtained in Italy, or equivalent qualification in the field of computer science gained abroad or obtained in Italy according to the regulation in force before M.D. 509/99
- b) bachelor degree in physics (L-30 Scienze e tecnologie fisiche), mathematics (L-35 Scienze matematiche) or industrial engineering (L-9 Ingegneria industriale) obtained in Italy, or equivalent qualification in the field of physics, mathematics or statistics gained abroad or obtained in Italy according to the regulation in force before M.D. 509/99.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

- 1. Curriculum: The study curriculum and curriculum vitae together are scored up to 10 points;
- 2. **Type of Bachelor degree**: Qualifications listed under point a) are awarded 3 points; qualifications listed under point b) are awarded 1-2 points.
- 3. **Bachelor final grade**: the score awarded for the study curriculum is weighed on the basis of the "Webometrics Ranking of World Universities", proceeding as follows::
 - 3 points for universities in position from 1 to 1000 in the ranking;
 - o 2 points for universities in position from 1001 to 2000;
 - o 1 point for universities in position from 2001 to 3000 in the ranking;
 - 0,5 points for universities in position from 3001 to 4000 in the ranking
 - 0 points for universities in position from 4001 onwards;
- 4. **Working Experience**: The working experience in the field of computer science is weighed from 0 to 3 points with 0 less than one year of experience and 3 with three or more years of experience.

English proficiency: The certificate of English language proficiency (B2) does not give a score but is an admission prerequisite.

The final score is computed as weighted average of the above criteria with Curriculum weight = 1, BSc type weight = 0.3, BSc final mark weight = 0.6, Experience weight = 0.1. Minimum final score to pass is 6.

CONFIRMATION OF STUDY PLACE AND ENROLMENT

If you have been admitted through the ranking list you must:

- 1) select the degree course in the application portal and pay with one of the indicated payment methods to confirm the study place within 28 May 2020, 12 midday.

 The first instalment of tuition fees amounts to 748,50 EUR.
- 2) from 15 July until 16 October 2020, 12 midday, enrol online in the application portal.



If you do not respect the deadlines, <u>you will automatically lose your place</u> which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

If by paying the 1st instalment you have confirmed the study place, there will be no refund of the tuition fees unless you are a non-EU applicant living abroad and you do not receive the documents necessary for enrolment from the Italian authorities in your country.

If you have been admitted to more than one study programme, you can only secure your admission in one of them. Doing so you refrain from the admission to other programmes and lose the right to move up in the other ranking lists.

If you do not have the required academic qualification, you will be given a conditional offer for a study place and you must submit your qualification upon enrolment. If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you cannot enrol, and you will lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list. **Advice**: If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you should not pay the tuition fees to confirm the study place. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request and, only if there are study places still available, you can enrol by 18 December 2020.

Please note that you do not gain full student status by only paying the tuition fees. This status will only be acquired upon enrolment.

If you have gained your qualification abroad, you must upload in the application portal (if not uploaded upon application):

- diploma of your qualification;
- official translation of your diploma into Italian (translation is not necessary if the certificates have been issued in German or English);
- the Diploma supplement, where it must be indicated:
 - that you have achieved at least 180 credit points (ECTS) and
 - that the study title gives access to a Master course.

In case of doubt, unibz reserves the right to request further documents (e.g. declaration of equivalent value).

• the declaration of equivalent value of your qualification, in the case the Diploma supplement is missing.

Please note: If you have gained your qualification abroad and have not uploaded your diploma, you are provisionally admitted until your study title can be verified.

At the beginning of the academic year you must submit <u>the originals</u> of the above mentioned documents to the Student Secretariat.

If you have been admitted in the ranking list, but you do not possess a valid admission qualification, you can be excluded with Rector's decree even after enrolment.

Further information for non-EU applicants resident abroad:

As a <u>non-EU citizen living abroad</u>, you will also have to **apply at the Italian authorities** (consulate or embassy) in your country. The deadlines set by the Italian Ministry of Education, Universities and Research (http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/) must be met. At the Italian authorities, you can apply for one study programme only. Should you not follow this procedure with the local Italian authorities, your direct online application to unibz will be declared null and void.

According to Italian law, within 8 working days of your arrival in Italy, you must have applied for the **residence permit**: as soon as you arrive, get in touch with the Advisory Service and you will be given the necessary information for starting the procedure.



Once you will obtain your residence permit (permesso di soggiorno), you have to hand it in at the Student Secretariat personally or via e-mail.

<u>Please note</u>: If you have declared to be resident in Italy, but have not attached to your application a copy of your **valid residence permit** for Italy (see article 39, paragraph 5 of decree no. 286 of 25.07.1998) you are ranked together with the non-EU citizen resident abroad.
