REQUIREMENTS

Applicants who successfully passed the selection procedure are admitted through the ranking lists.

To enter the Master, the academic requisites are:

- a degree title under former DM 270/04 classes in the L-7, and L-9 or university degree in Classes 8 and 10 ex DM 509/99 and a minimum number of credit points (CP) in specific scientific groups of scientific sectors achieved in the previous career as from the table indicated in the study manifesto.
- An average grade higher or equal to 22/30, weighted on credits (excluding the final exam). The grade "30 cum laude" is computed as 31/30 in the calculation of the average.
- All other cases (degree title under former DM 270/04 in classes other than L-7 and L-9, or degree title under DM 509/99 in classes other than No. 8 and No. 10, or other equivalent degree belonging to the former regulation or other degree title obtained abroad and recognized as equivalent) will be evaluated by the Interuniversity Course Council considering appropriate equivalence between the content and the courses attended in previous careers and those corresponding to the subject areas listed in the above mentioned table.

In order to be admitted to the programme, you must possess proven language skills at the B2 level (Common European Framework of Reference) of the English language and A1 (Common European Framework of Reference) in at least one of the two other teaching languages (German, Italian). In case the language requirement in German or Italian was not certified, the required A1 level in the second language (German or Italian) has been verified by the Admissions Committee during the interview.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The ranking lists are created following the criteria as below:

- Curriculum studiorum:
Evaluation of the first level education (i.e. Grade Point Average and class qualification, professional experience and educational background) and coherence with the master's learning objectives (0-65)
- Language certifications if level is higher than the minimum admission requirement (0-10)
- Interview (in person or via skype call only upon a reasonable request sent by the candidate)
- The interview aims at taking a deeper look at the personal skills and background of the student with respect to the master's learning objectives (0-25)

CONFIRMATION OF STUDY PLACE AND ENROLMENT

If you have been admitted through the ranking you must:

- 1) select the degree course in the application portal and pay with one of the indicated payment methods to confirm the study place within 28 May 2020, 12 midday.**
The first instalment of tuition fees amounts to 748,50 EUR.
- 2) from 15 July until 16 October 2020, 12 midday, enrol online** in the application portal.

If you do not respect the deadlines, you will automatically lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

If by paying the 1st instalment you have confirmed the study place, but you do not enrol, there will be no refund of the tuition fees unless you are a non-EU applicant resident abroad and you do not receive the necessary documents from the Italian authorities in your country.

If you have been admitted to more than one degree courses, you can only confirm a study place in one of them. With this confirmation you refrain from the admission to the other degree courses and lose the right to move up in the other ranking lists.

If you do not have the required academic qualification, you will be given a conditional offer for a study place and you must submit your qualification upon enrolment. If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you cannot enrol and you will lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list. **Suggestion:** If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you should not pay the tuition fees to confirm the study place. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request to the Rector and, only if there are study places still available, you can enrol by December 18, 2020.

Please note that payment does not allow you to receive student status, which will be acquired upon enrolment.

Applicants with qualifications gained abroad must upload in the application portal (if not uploaded upon application):

- diploma of your qualification;
- official translation of your diploma into Italian (translation is not necessary if the certificates have been issued in German or English);
- the Diploma supplement, where it must be indicated:
 - that the student has achieved at least 180 credit points (ECTS) and
 - that the study title gives access to a Master course.In case of doubt, unibz reserves the right to request further documents (e.g. declaration of equivalent value).
- the declaration of equivalent value of the applicant qualification, in the case the Diploma supplement is missing;

Attention: If you have gained your qualification abroad and have not uploaded your diploma, you are provisionally admitted until your study title can be verified.

At the beginning of the academic year you have to submit the originals of the above mentioned documents to the Student Secretariat.

If you have been admitted in the ranking list, but you do not possess a valid entrance qualification, you can be excluded with Rector's decree even after enrolment.

Further information for non-EU applicants resident abroad:

If you are a non-EU applicants resident abroad, in addition to applying directly to the university, you must carry out the **enrolment procedures also through the Italian authorities** (consulate or embassy) in the country in which you obtained or are to obtain your academic qualifications. The deadlines established by the Italian Ministry of Education, Universities and Research (<http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studenti stranieri/>) must be respected. Should you not follow this

procedure with your local Italian consulate, the application that you delivered directly to the university will be declared null and void.

According to Italian law, within 8 working days of your arrival in Italy, you must have applied for the **permit to stay**: as soon as you arrive you should go to the Advisory Service and you will be given all the information so that you can start this procedure.

Once you will obtain your permit of stay for Italy (permesso di soggiorno), you have to deliver it to the Student Secretariat personally or via e-mail.

Please note: Non-EU applicants who declared their residence in Italy, but have not attached to their application a copy of their **valid permit of stay** for Italy (see article 39, paragraph 5 of decree no. 286 of 25.07.1998) are ranked together with the non-EU citizen resident abroad.
