Given the Convention between the Free University of Bozen-Bolzano and the Edmund Mach-Center Research and Innovation Foundation for the co-financing of a scholarship for the PhD programme MOUNTAIN ENVIRONMENT AND AGRICULTURE (Agricoltura e ambiente montano), approved by emergency court order of the President of the University Council no. 16, 29 June 2017,

Given the emergency court order of the President of the University Council no. 17, 29 June 2017,

the Free University of Bozen-Bolzano hereby advertises

to increase the number of places in the PhD programme **MOUNTAIN ENVIRONMENT AND AGRICULTURE (Agricoltura e ambiente montano) (MEA)** as follow.

A public competition for the allocation of

- 10 places (instead of 9) is announced of which 8 (instead of 7) will be covered by scholarships, moreover 3 places reserved for students of foreign countries in possession of a scholarship.

The integrated scholarship is linked to this research topic: "New strategies in organic pest insect control by the characterization of bioactive plant volatile organic compounds of agricultural crops".

The integrated scholarship is awarded within the first curriculum of the PhD programme in MOUNTAIN ENVIRONMENT AND AGRICULTURE (MEA).
