

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE STRUCTURE OF THE LANGUAGE EXAM FOR APPLICANTS APPLYING TO BE ADMITTED TO THE FREE UNIVERSITY OF BOZEN-BOLZANO

Module I and II take place in the morning.

Module III (oral exam) takes place in the early afternoon.

Exam access credentials and exact times will be sent by e-mail a few days before the exam. Please be on time.

Once you have logged in together with the Invigilator (first person supervising the exam) and taken the audio test (the audio test takes place during module I), we strongly recommend that you read the instructions for each exercise carefully.

## Module I

- During module I (listening and reading), it is not possible to go back to the previous sections.
- Each audio can be listened to twice.
- Do not ever use any keyboard combinations to copy/delete/cut/paste text, otherwise everything you have written may be lost.

The results will appear on your screen at the end of the first part of the exam (Module I= Listening and Reading):

- **1.** If you do not pass module I, then your exam will have ended. Please physically raise your hand before leaving the room with the Proctor's (the second person supervising the exam) help.
- 2. If you pass Module I, carry on with the second part of the exam (Module II= Written Exam) by clicking on the link you will find on the page containing the results of module I (you do not need to raise your hand, unless there are any problems).

  Before leaving the meeting, please raise your hand at the end of the written exam and the Invigilator will check that the written exam has been saved correctly.

## **Module II**

If you only need to complete Module II, then the system will give you immediate access to the written exam.

• Do not ever use any keyboard combinations to copy/delete/cut/paste text, otherwise everything you have written may be lost.

If you are sitting level B1, it is necessary to write two texts, for levels B2 and C1 you only need choose one of the two tasks and write one text.

## **Module III**

During the oral exam, you can take notes: please have a blank piece of paper and a pen ready.

The oral exam consists of 2 monologues: the theme of the monologue and prompts appear at the top of the screen in each monologue. For each of the two monologues, there is some preparation time during which notes can be taken. The preparation time for each monologue is followed by the task itself during which the monologue will be recorded (the amount of preparation time and length of the monologues depend on the level of the exam).

Once both monologues have been completed, please physically raise your hand and wait. The Invigilator will check that the recordings have been successfully recorded.
