

SCORES AND EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR THE LANGUAGE EXAM OF THE FREE UNIVERSITY OF BOZEN-BOLZANO

MODULE I (LISTENING, READING)

To pass Module I, which is a prerequisite for the other 2 modules, at least 60% of the available points must be achieved (24 out of 40 points).

MODULE II (WRITTEN PRODUCTION)

The written tests are evaluated according to the following four criteria, each with a score from 0 to 5:

Content and task completion: Assesses the completeness, relevance, and depth with which the required points are addressed.

Lexis: Considers the breadth and appropriateness of vocabulary, use of synonyms, collocations, and the ability to compensate for any gaps.

Grammar, spelling and punctuation: Measures the variety and correctness of grammatical structures, as well as spelling accuracy and punctuation use.

Coherence and cohesion: Evaluates the logical organization of the text, effective use of connectors and cohesive devices, and clarity in the hierarchy of information

To pass Module II, at least 60% of the available points must be achieved (12 out of 20).

MODULE III (ORAL PRODUCTION)

The oral tests are evaluated according to the following four criteria, each with a score from 0 to 5:

Communicative effectiveness: Concerns the ability to complete assigned tasks, organize speech, and ensure content relevance.

Lexis: Evaluates the breadth of vocabulary, the ability to express oneself clearly, and to compensate for any gaps.

Grammar: Considers the variety and correctness of the grammatical structures used.

Fluency, pronunciation, and intonation: Measures speech fluency, pronunciation clarity, and use of intonation.

To pass Module III, at least 60% of the available points must be achieved (12 out of 20).
