* Only for dual programmes (Bachelor in Industrial Mechanical Engineering) the minimum entry requirement is B1 in the second language. For the Bachelor's programmes in Electronics and Cyber-Physical Systems Engineering and in Enogastronomy in Mountain Areas only: Applicants with a B1 level in the 2nd language may be admitted if there are any places available. For these two study programmes only, the exit level in the second language is B2.

** A B1 level in the third language is required to take curricular exams in that language. For the Bachelors of the Faculty of Education: from the second semester of the first year. For the Bachelors in Design and Art only: in the first year of study it is possible to sit exams relating to project-based activities before having achieved a B1 level in the third language.
