





MINISTERIAL DECREE 351/2023

ALLOCATION OF DOCTORAL SCHOLARSHIPS UNDER THE PNRR

By Ministerial Decree No. 351 of 09 April 2022, the Ministry of Universities and Research (https://www.mur.gov.it/it/atti-e-normativa/decreto-ministeriale-n351-del-09-04-2022) awarded 2500 three-year innovative PhD scholarships under the PNRR (National Recovery and Resilience Plan submitted to the European Commission pursuant to Art. 18 et seq. of Regulation (EU) 2021/241), Mission 4, Component 2 ("From Research to Enterprise"), Mission 4, Component 1 ("Strengthening the supply of education services: from kindergartens to universities"), as part of the following investments:

- Investment 3.4 "Advanced university teaching and skills";
- Investment 4.1 'Extension of the number of PhDs and innovative PhDs for public administration and cultural heritage'.

The three-year PhD programmes, accredited pursuant to Ministerial Decree 45/2013 XXXVII cycle - Academic Year 2021/2022 and to be accredited under Ministerial Decree 226/2021 XXXVIII cycle - Academic Year 2022/2023 are structured in dedicated programmes and are structured as follows:

- 100 PhD grants in programmes dedicated to digital and environmental transitions;
- 1,200 grants for PNRR PhDs;
- 1000 PhD grants for Public Administration;
- 200 grants for Cultural Heritage PhDs.

Resources within Mission 4 ("Education and Research"), Component 1, Investment 3.4.

The decree provides for the allocation of €30 million for the funding of PhD scholarships, from the resources provided by the PNRR under the above-mentioned measure Mission 4 ('Education and Research'), Component 1, Investment 3.4.

The Ministry also determines that the resources are aimed at supporting doctoral courses in programmes of digital and environmental transitions, within the cycle XXXIX, amounting to €6,000,000.

Resources within Mission 4 ("Education and Research"), Component 1, Investment 4.1

The decree provides for the allocation of €432,000,000.00 for the financing of research and innovative PhD scholarships for public administration and cultural heritage, from the resources provided for in the PNRR, Component 1, Investment 4.1, distributed as follows:

- PhD courses PNRR: € 72,000,000.00;
- PhD courses for Public Administration: € 12,000,000.00;
- PhD courses for Cultural Heritage: € 60,000,000.00.

Resources allocated to the Free University of Bozen/Bolzano

Ministerial Decree 351/2022 provides for the allocation of € **720,000.00** to the Free University of Bozen/Bolzano for a total of 13 scholarships distributed as follows:
