d) Bachelor degree, University diploma or equivalent degree of another class or study qualifications earned abroad can be valued as adequate if, during your study career and before the beginning of the admission procedure, you have gained 10 credit points in the following fields: Design, Architecture and Spatial Planning, Landscape architecture, Interior Design, Cinema, Photography or Informatics.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission to the Master in Eco-Social Design is also subject to passing the two-step selection procedure.

Stage 1:

The first step is an evaluation of the documents by the Selection Committee presented with the application.

Selection criteria of stage 1:

Portfolio: max 20 points; Outline of a project proposal: max 10 points.

In order to be eligible for the second stage, you must have obtained at least 15 points.

Stage 2:

Interview: max 20 points.

The second stage consists of an interview designed to assess the experience gained. In the interview the following will be discussed: experience in the field of the study programme, inter- and transdisciplinary experiences, innovative and creative thinking, ability to work in team, ability to discuss and to reflect critically.

Candidates must achieve a minimum score of 25/50 total points to be eligible for enrolment.

CONFIRMATION OF STUDY PLACE AND ENROLMENT

If you have been admitted through the ranking list, you must:

- 1) select the degree course in the Application portal and **pay with one of the indicated payment methods to confirm the study place within 27 May 2021, 12 midday**. The first instalment of tuition fees amounts to 448,50 EUR.
- 2) **from 14 July until 15 October 2021, 12 midday, enrol online** in the Application portal.

If you do not respect the deadlines, **you will automatically lose your place** which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

If by paying the 1st instalment you have confirmed the study place, there will be no refund of the tuition fees unless you are a non-EU applicant living abroad and you do not receive the documents necessary for enrolment from the Italian authorities in your country.

If you have been admitted to more than one study programme, you can only secure your admission in one of them. Doing so you refrain from the admission to other programmes and lose the right to move up in the other ranking lists.

If you do not have the required academic qualification, you will be given a conditional offer for a study place and you must submit your qualification upon enrolment. If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you cannot enrol, and you will lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list. **Advice:** If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you should not pay the tuition fees to confirm the study place. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request and, only if there are study places still available, you can enrol by 17 December 2021.

Please note that you do not gain full student status by only paying the tuition fees. This status will only be acquired upon enrolment.

If you have gained your qualification abroad, you must upload in the Application portal (if not uploaded upon application):

- diploma of your qualification;
- official translation of your diploma into Italian (translation is not necessary if the certificates have been issued in German or English);
- the Diploma supplement, where it must be indicated:
 - that you have achieved at least 180 credit points (ECTS) and
 - that the study title gives access to a Master course.

In case of doubt, unibz reserves the right to request further documents (e.g. declaration of equivalent value).

- the statement of comparability or the declaration of equivalent value of your qualification, in the case the Diploma supplement is missing.

Please note: If you have gained your qualification abroad and have not uploaded your diploma, you are provisionally admitted until your study title can be verified.

If you have been admitted in the ranking list, but you do not possess a valid admission qualification, you can be excluded with Rector's decree even after enrolment.

Further information for non-EU applicants living abroad:

As a **non-EU citizen living abroad**, you will also have to **apply on the portal University** of the Italian Ministry of Universities and Research (<https://www.universitaly.it/strutture/>). In University you can apply for one study programme only. Should you not follow this procedure, your direct online application to unibz will be declared null and void.

According to Italian law, within 8 working days of your arrival in Italy, you must apply for the **residence permit**: as soon as you arrive, get in touch with the Advisory Service and you will be given the necessary information for starting the procedure.

Once you obtain your residence permit (permesso di soggiorno), you have to hand it in at the Student Secretariat personally or via e-mail.

Please note: If you have declared to be resident in Italy, but have not attached to your application a copy of your **valid residence permit** for Italy (see article 39, paragraph 5 of decree no. 286 of 25.07.1998) you are ranked together with the non-EU citizen resident abroad.
