## **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

Admission to the master programme requires the possession of one of the following qualifications:

a) Italian bachelor degree (\*) in one of the following classes or in an equivalent study qualification earned abroad:

1. Ex M.D. 270/04: Bachelor degree in the classes:

L-4 Disegno industriale

L-17 Scienze dell'Architettura

L-21 Scienze della pianificazione territoriale, urbanistica, paesaggistica e ambientale

2. Ex M.D. 509/99: Bachelor degree in the classes:

42 Disegno industriale

04 Scienze dell'architettura e dell'ingegneria edile

07 Urbanistica e scienza della pianificazione territoriale, urbanistica, paesaggistica e ambientale

(\*) In every case, Italian citizens with a foreign university degree must have a high school diploma.

or

c) If you have another Italian degree, you need 10 credit points in the following scientific disciplinary sectors:

ICAR/13 Industrial Design

ICAR/14 Architectural and Urban Composition

ICAR/15 Landscape Design

ICAR/16 Interior and Decorative Architecture

ICAR/17 Representation of Architecture

ICAR/21 Urban design and landscape

If you have a degree from the Italian old system (prior to D.M. 509/99), a title from an AFAM-institute (Alta formazione artistica e musicale - Higher Artistic and Musical Education), or a degree obtained abroad\*, the selection committee will examine your career to determine your eligibility for admission.

(\*) Italian citizen who have obtained their degree abroad must also have a secondary school leaving qualification.

Admission to the Master in Eco-Social Design is also subject to passing the two-step selection procedure.

Stage 1:

The first step is an evaluation of the documents by the Selection Committee presented with the application.

Selection criteria of stage 1:

Portfolio: max 20 points; Outline of a project proposal: max 20 points.

In order to be eligible for the second stage, you must have obtained at least 20 points.

Stage 2:

Interview: max 20 points.

The second stage consists of an interview designed to assess the experience gained. In the interview the following will be discussed: experience in the field of the study programme, inter- and transdisciplinary experiences, innovative and creative thinking, ability to work in team, ability to discuss and to reflect critically.

Candidates must achieve a minimum score of 30/60 total points to be eligible for enrolment.

### **CONFIRMATION OF STUDY PLACE AND ENROLMENT**

If you have been admitted through the ranking list, you must:

- 1) select the degree course in the Application portal and pay with one of the indicated payment methods to confirm the study place within 5 June 2025, 12 (midday). The first instalment of tuition fees amounts to € 600.00.
- 2) from 11 July until 14 October 2025, 12 (midday), enrol online in the Application portal.

If you do not respect the deadlines, you will automatically lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

If by paying the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment you have confirmed the study place, there will be no refund of the tuition fees unless you are a non-EU applicant living abroad and you do not receive the documents necessary for enrolment from the Italian authorities in your country.

According to national regulations, simultaneous enrolment in a maximum of 2 programmes is possible (however, the two programmes must not belong to the same class, e.g., LM-18/LM-18 and must differ for at least 2/3 of the course activities).

If you have been admitted to more than one study programme, you can confirm your place for a maximum of 2 programmes by paying the designated fee twice.

If you do not have the required academic qualification, you will be given a conditional offer for a study place, and you must submit your qualification upon enrolment. If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you cannot enrol, and you will lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

Advice: If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you should not pay the tuition fees to confirm the study place. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request and, only if there are study places still available, you can enrol by 12 December 2025.

If you have been admitted in the ranking list, but you do not possess a valid admission qualification, you can be excluded with Rector's decree even after enrolment.

**Please note** that you do not gain full student status by only paying the tuition fees. This status will only be acquired upon enrolment.

### **ENROLMENT WITH QUALIFICATIONS GAINED ABROAD**

If you have gained your qualification abroad, at enrolment you must upload in the Application portal (if not uploaded upon application):

- the degree diploma of your Bachelor;
- the official translation of your degree into Italian (translation is not necessary if the documents have been issued in German or English);
- the Diploma supplement, where it must be indicated:
  - that you have achieved at least 180 credit points (ECTS) and
  - that the qualification gives access to a Master programme.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in an EU country or in Switzerland, Norway, Iceland, or Liechtenstein, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Correspondence of your Bachelor degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a non-EU country that is signatory to the Lisbon Convention, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Correspondence of your Bachelor degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy
- the Statement of Verification of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a non-EU country that is not signatory to the Lisbon Convention, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Comparability of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA)
- the Statement of Verification of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

Your admission will be under reservation until the above-mentioned documents are uploaded.

During enrolment, unibz verifies your foreign qualification and may request additional documents if necessary.

If the access title is deemed eligible, the reservation will be lifted. Otherwise, enrolment will not be possible and you will be excluded.

### INFORMATION FOR NON-EU CITIZENS LIVING ABROAD

Non-EU citizen living abroad will also have to apply on the University portal of the Italian Ministry of Universities and Research. In University you can apply for one study programme only. Should you not follow this procedure, your direct online application to unibz will be declared null and void.

Please note that preliminary admission by unibz does not guarantee obtaining a visa, the issuing of which is the exclusive responsibility of embassies and consulates. Likewise, obtaining a visa for study purposes does not confer any right to perfecting the enrolment in a study programme.

Once you have obtained your visa, and within 8 working days of your arrival in Italy, according to Italian law you must apply for a residence permit: as soon as you arrive, get in touch with the Student Support and you will be given the necessary information for starting the procedure.

Once you obtain your residence permit (permesso di soggiorno), you have to hand it in at the Student Office personally or via e-mail.

**Please note:** If you have declared to be resident in Italy but have not attached to your application a copy of your valid residence permit for Italy (see article 39, paragraph 5 of decree no. 286 of 25.07.1998) you are ranked together with the non-EU citizen resident abroad.
