# Admission to the Master in Smart Sustainable Agriculture Systems in Mountain Areas (LM-69)

## ADMISSION CRITERIA

In order to gain admission to this programme without the need for further verification you need the following qualifications:

- an adequate knowledge of the basic disciplines of Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics and Biology and fundamental knowledge of the subjects preparatory to the fundamental disciplines of this degree class.
- Bachelor graduates of the following Italian course categories (according to Ministerial Decree no. 270/04):
  - L-25 Agricultural, agri-food and forestry sciences and technologies
  - L-13 Biological sciences
  - L-32 Science and technology for the environment and nature
  - L-38 Zootechnical sciences and animal production technologies,
- as well as titles from the previous system that were equivalent to them, or a foreign title recognized as comparable.
- In the presence of a three-year degree other than those listed above, candidates must have taken:

- at least 20 ECTS of core subject areas (SSDs) among those listed in the Ministerial Decree of degree classes for class L-25, and

- at least 30 ECTS of characterizing subject areas (SSDs) from among those listed in the Ministerial Decree of the degree classes for the L-25 category, relating to at least two subject areas.

- For holders of a qualification obtained abroad, ECTS to SSDs will be allocated based on the evaluation of the contents of the courses followed in the student's previous career.
- Any curricular integrations in terms of ECTS must be acquired prior to enrolment.



### If you have not yet graduated at the time of application

Candidates not yet in possession of the required three-year degree may apply for pre-enrolment, but must be in possession of the qualification by the registration deadline at the latest, under penalty of exclusion from the procedure. Possession of the qualification must be certified at the time of registration.

To be admitted you must fulfil the language requirements indicated in the section "Language requirements".

According to national regulations, simultaneous enrolment in a maximum of 2 programmes is possible (however, the two programmes must not belong to the same class, e.g., LM-73/LM-73 and must differ for at least 2/3 of the course contents).

#### **Admission procedure**

The Admission Committee can assign up to a max. of 95 points based on the:

- final bachelor grade expressed out of 30 (for applicants already graduated)
- weighted grade average expressed out of 30 (for applicants not graduated yet)

The Admission Committee will assign 2 points to candidates who graduated with honors (cum laude).

Candidates who possess at least a C1 certificate in the official teaching language of the course (English) will be assigned 3 points.

Minimum score for admission: 55 points

The evaluation is carried out exclusively on the basis of the documentation produced by the candidate with the pre-application.

The ranking is determined on the basis of the score obtained in the assessment. In the event of a tied score, the candidate or applicant already in possession of the degree shall have priority in the ranking. In the event of a further equal number of points, the youngest candidate or applicant has priority.

#### CONFIRMATION OF STUDY PLACE AND ENROLMENT

If you have been admitted through the ranking list, you must:

- 1) select the degree course in the Application portal and pay with one of the indicated payment methods to confirm the study place within 5 June 2025, 12 (midday). The first instalment of tuition fees amounts to € 600.00.
- 2) from 11 July until 14 October 2025, 12 (midday), enrol online in the Application portal.

If you do not respect the deadlines, you will automatically lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

If by paying the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment you have confirmed the study place, there will be no refund of the tuition fees unless you are a non-EU applicant living abroad and you do not receive the documents necessary for enrolment from the Italian authorities in your country.



According to national regulations, simultaneous enrolment in a maximum of 2 programmes is possible (however, the two programmes must not belong to the same class, e.g., LM-18/LM-18 and must differ for at least 2/3 of the course activities).

If you have been admitted to more than one study programme, you can confirm your place for a maximum of 2 programmes by paying the designated fee twice.

If you do not have the required academic qualification, you will be given a conditional offer for a study place, and you must submit your qualification upon enrolment. If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you cannot enrol, and you will lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

Advice: If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you should not pay the tuition fees to confirm the study place. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request and, only if there are study places still available, you can enrol by 12 December 2025.

If you have been admitted in the ranking list, but you do not possess a valid admission qualification, you can be excluded with Rector's decree even after enrolment.

**Please note** that you do not gain full student status by only paying the tuition fees. This status will only be acquired upon enrolment.

#### ENROLMENT WITH QUALIFICATIONS GAINED ABROAD

If you have gained your qualification abroad, at enrolment you must upload in the Application portal (if not uploaded upon application):

- the degree diploma of your Bachelor;
- the official translation of your degree into Italian (translation is not necessary if the documents have been issued in German or English);
- the Diploma supplement, where it must be indicated:
  - that you have achieved at least 180 credit points (ECTS) and
  - that the qualification gives access to a Master programme.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in an EU country or in Switzerland, Norway, Iceland, or Liechtenstein, at enrolment you must also upload:

• the Statement of Correspondence of your Bachelor degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a non-EU country that is signatory to the Lisbon Convention, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Correspondence of your Bachelor degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI -Automatic Recognition Database – Italy
- the Statement of Verification of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a non-EU country that is not signatory to the Lisbon Convention, at enrolment you must also upload:



- the Statement of Comparability of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA)
- the Statement of Verification of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

Your admission will be under reservation until the above-mentioned documents are uploaded.

During enrolment, unibz verifies your foreign qualification and may request additional documents if necessary.

If the access title is deemed eligible, the reservation will be lifted. Otherwise, enrolment will not be possible and you will be excluded.

#### INFORMATION FOR NON-EU CITIZENS LIVING ABROAD

Non-EU citizen living abroad will also have to apply on the Universitaly portal of the Italian Ministry of Universities and Research. In Universitaly you can apply for one study programme only. Should you not follow this procedure, your direct online application to unibz will be declared null and void.

Please note that preliminary admission by unibz does not guarantee obtaining a visa, the issuing of which is the exclusive responsibility of embassies and consulates. Likewise, obtaining a visa for study purposes does not confer any right to perfecting the enrolment in a study programme.

Once you have obtained your visa, and within 8 working days of your arrival in Italy, according to Italian law you must apply for a residence permit: as soon as you arrive, get in touch with the Student Support and you will be given the necessary information for starting the procedure.

Once you obtain your residence permit (permesso di soggiorno), you have to hand it in at the Student Office personally or via e-mail.

**Please note**: If you have declared to be resident in Italy but have not attached to your application a copy of your valid residence permit for Italy (see article 39, paragraph 5 of decree no. 286 of 25.07.1998) you are ranked together with the non-EU citizen resident abroad.
