ADMISSION CRITERIA

Admission to the master programme requires the possession of one of the following qualifications:

1. A bachelor degree (*) in one of the following Italian degree classes or an equivalent qualification gained abroad:

4. a bachelor degree, university diploma or equivalent degree of another class or study qualifications earned abroad can be valued as adequate if, during your study career and before the beginning of the admission procedure, you have gained 12 credit points in the following fields: Design, Architecture, Arts, Museology, Cinema, Photography, Media Studies or Philosophy. A commission checks the validity and equivalence of the credit points.

If you have not yet graduated at the time of application:

You can apply, but you will be admitted conditionally and need to submit your diploma by the enrolment deadline.

If you graduate after the enrolment deadline:

You cannot enrol and you will lose your place, which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list. In this case you should not pay the tuition fees to secure your admission. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request and, only if there still are available places, you can enrol by 12 December 2025.

To be admitted you must fulfil following language requirement:

English: B2

Admission to the Master in Critical Creative Practices is also subject to passing the two-stage selection procedure.

Stage 1:

The first stage is an evaluation of the documents that must be uploaded by the application deadline.

In Stage 1 will be evaluated the following documents:

- Curriculum vitae: max 20 points
- Portfolio: max 20 points
- Outline of a project proposal: max 20 points

Candidates must achieve a minimum score of 30/60 total points in Stage 1, in order to be admitted to Stage 2.

Stage 2:

The second stage consists in an online interview aimed at having a dialogue to gain a deeper understanding on the candidate's ideas, experiences and points of view.

Will be evaluated:

- Interdisciplinary interest
- Communication skills

- Creative abilities of the candidates

Candidates must achieve a minimum score of 60/100 total points to be eligible for the enrolment.

CONFIRMATION OF STUDY PLACE AND ENROLMENT

If you have been admitted through the ranking list, you must:

- 1) select the degree course in the Application portal and pay with one of the indicated payment methods to confirm the study place within 5 August 2025, 12 (midday). The first instalment of tuition fees amounts to € 600.00.
- 2) until 14 October 2025, 12 (midday), enrol online in the Application portal.

If you do not respect the deadlines, you will automatically lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

If by paying the 1st instalment you have confirmed the study place, there will be no refund of the tuition fees.

According to national regulations, simultaneous enrolment in a maximum of 2 programmes is possible (however, the two programmes must not belong to the same class, e.g., LM-18/LM-18 and must differ for at least 2/3 of the course activities).

If you have been admitted to more than one study programme, you can confirm your place for a maximum of 2 programmes by paying the designated fee twice.

If you do not have the required academic qualification, you will be given a conditional offer for a study place, and you must submit your qualification upon enrolment. If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you cannot enrol, and you will lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

Advice: If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you should not pay the tuition fees to confirm the study place. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request and, only if there are study places still available, you can enrol by 12 December 2025.

If you have been admitted in the ranking list, but you do not possess a valid admission qualification, you can be excluded with Rector's decree even after enrolment.

Please note that you do not gain full student status by only paying the tuition fees. This status will only be acquired upon enrolment.

ENROLMENT WITH QUALIFICATIONS GAINED ABROAD

If you have gained your qualification abroad, at enrolment you must upload in the Application portal (if not uploaded upon application):

- the degree diploma of your Bachelor;
- the official translation of your degree into Italian (translation is not necessary if the documents have been issued in German or English);

- the Diploma supplement, where it must be indicated:
 - that you have achieved at least 180 credit points (ECTS) and
 - that the qualification gives access to a Master programme.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in an EU country or in Switzerland, Norway, Iceland, or Liechtenstein, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Correspondence of your Bachelor degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a non-EU country that is signatory to the Lisbon Convention, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Correspondence of your Bachelor degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy
- the Statement of Verification of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a non-EU country that is not signatory to the Lisbon Convention, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Comparability of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA)
- the Statement of Verification of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

Your admission will be under reservation until the above-mentioned documents are uploaded.

During enrolment, unibz verifies your foreign qualification and may request additional documents if necessary.

If the access title is deemed eligible, the reservation will be lifted. Otherwise, enrolment will not be possible and you will be excluded.
