ADMISSION CRITERIA

The admission procedure is based on the following criteria:

1. Grade point average (max. 70 points)
 - Degree obtained: the final university grade expressed in thirtieths
 - Degree not obtained: the average university grade expressed in thirtieths.

In the case of a degree awarded with top marks and "cum laude", an additional 2 points are awarded.
2. Start-up project (max. 30 points)

The start-up project will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

 - Originality of the idea
 - Coherence of the idea in the presentation: Coherence in the content and development of the different elements.
 - Impact of the idea in terms of change (e.g. social impact, job creation)
 - Development of the idea (e.g. assessment of the problem/solution, creation of a prototype, etc.)
3. Minimum of points to reach to be admitted to the ranking: 70 points
This minimum of points has to be reached by adding the points of criteria 1 and 2.

Only complete dossiers will be evaluated. The missing of one or more of the documents required under a) and b) will result in the exclusion of the candidate from the ranking list.

In the event of equal scores, priority will be given to the applicant who has obtained the highest score for the first criterion. If scores are still equal, the younger applicant will have priority.

Courses included in the programme of the Master in Entrepreneurship and Innovation are not valid for the acquisition of the required 12 ECTS credit points.

Courses that have been taken into consideration in order to achieve the 12 ECTS credit points necessary to gain admission to the master programme cannot be recognized for a possible career abbreviation.

CONFIRMATION OF STUDY PLACE AND ENROLMENT

If you have been admitted through the ranking list, you must:

- 1) select the degree course in the Application portal and pay with one of the indicated payment methods to confirm the study place within 19 August 2025, 12 (midday). The first instalment of tuition fees amounts to € 600.00.
- 2) until 14 October 2025, 12 (midday), enrol online in the Application portal.

If you do not respect the deadlines, you will automatically lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

If by paying the 1st instalment you have confirmed the study place, there will be no refund of the tuition fees.

According to national regulations, simultaneous enrolment in a maximum of 2 programmes is possible (however, the two programmes must not belong to the same class, e.g., LM-18/LM-18 and must differ for at least 2/3 of the course activities).

If you have been admitted to more than one study programme, you can confirm your place for a maximum of 2 programmes by paying the designated fee twice.

If you do not have the required academic qualification, you will be given a conditional offer for a study place, and you must submit your qualification upon enrolment. If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you cannot enrol, and you will lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

Advice: If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you should not pay the tuition fees to confirm the study place. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request and, only if there are study places still available, you can enrol by 12 December 2025.

If you have been admitted in the ranking list, but you do not possess a valid admission qualification, you can be excluded with Rector's decree even after enrolment.

Please note that you do not gain full student status by only paying the tuition fees. This status will only be acquired upon enrolment.

ENROLMENT WITH QUALIFICATIONS GAINED ABROAD

If you have gained your qualification abroad, at enrolment you must upload in the Application portal (if not uploaded upon application):

- the degree diploma of your Bachelor;
- the official translation of your degree into Italian (translation is not necessary if the documents have been issued in German or English);
- the Diploma supplement, where it must be indicated:
 - that you have achieved at least 180 credit points (ECTS) and

- that the qualification gives access to a Master programme.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in an EU country or in Switzerland, Norway, Iceland, or Liechtenstein, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Correspondence of your Bachelor degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a non-EU country that is signatory to the Lisbon Convention, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Correspondence of your Bachelor degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy
- the Statement of Verification of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a non-EU country that is not signatory to the Lisbon Convention, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Comparability of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA)
- the Statement of Verification of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

Your admission will be under reservation until the above-mentioned documents are uploaded.

During enrolment, unibz verifies your foreign qualification and may request additional documents if necessary.

If the access title is deemed eligible, the reservation will be lifted. Otherwise, enrolment will not be possible and you will be excluded.

Please note: If you have declared to be resident in Italy but have not attached to your application a copy of your valid residence permit for Italy (see article 39, paragraph 5 of decree no. 286 of 25.07.1998) you will be excluded from the ranklist.
