ADMISSION CRITERIA

In order to gain admission, candidates need one of the following admission titles:

- a bachelor's degree in Computer Science (class L-31) or Information Engineering (class L-08) or an equivalent qualification according to the previous regulations obtained in Italy, or an equivalent qualification obtained abroad (for example: Computer Science, Software Engineering, Business Informatics, Information Engineering);

or, alternatively,

- a bachelor's degree in any discipline, together with following curricular requirements obtained through bachelor's degrees, master's degrees, or single subject courses:
 - at least 12 ECTS in
 - INFO-01/A (ex INF/01) - Computer Science
 - IINF-05/A (ex ING-INF/05) - Information Processing Systems
 - at least 12 ECTS in
 - MATH-01/A (ex MAT/01) - Mathematical logic
 - MATH-02/A (ex MAT/02) - Algebra
 - MATH-02/B (ex MAT/03) - Geometry
 - MATH-03/A (ex MAT/05) - Mathematical Analysis
 - MATH-03/B (ex MAT/06) - Mathematical Probability and Statistics
 - MATH-04/A (ex MAT/07) - Mathematical Physics
 - MATH-05/A (ex MAT/08) - Numerical Analysis
 - MATH-06/A (ex MAT/09) - Operational Research
 - STAT-01/A (ex SECS-S/01) - Statistics
 - STAT-01/B (ex SECS-S/02) - Statistics for Experimental and Technological Research
 - STAT-02/A (ex SECS-S/03) - Economic Statistics
 - PHYS-01/A (ex FIS/01 and FIS/04) - Experimental Physics of Fundamental Interactions and Applications
 - PHYS-02/A (ex FIS/02 and FIS/04) - Theoretical Physics of Fundamental Interactions, Models, Mathematical Methods and Applications
 - PHYS-03/A (ex FIS/01 and FIS/03) - Experimental Physics of Matter and Applications
 - PHYS-04/A (ex FIS/02 and FIS/03) - Theoretical Physics of Matter, Models, Mathematical Methods and Applications

For candidates with a qualification obtained abroad the verification of the curricular requirements is based on the specific contents of the educational activities.

Candidates must have an average mark of at least 24/30.

Candidates below this average mark must pass an online interview in English in which they demonstrate their knowledge in topics such as Programming Languages and Paradigms, Data Structures and Algorithms, Database Management Systems, Linear Algebra, Probability Theory.

If you have not yet graduated at the time of application: you can apply if you have acquired at least 120 credit points (ECTS). In this case you will be admitted conditionally submitting your diploma by the enrolment deadline.

If you graduate after the enrolment deadline: you cannot enrol and you will lose your place, which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list. In this case you should not pay the tuition fees to secure your admission. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request and, only if there still are available places, you can enrol by 12 December 2025.

To be admitted candidates must have a B2 level in English according to the Common European Framework of Reference.

The evaluation criteria are:

- the admission title is scored up to 10 points based on the grade average obtained at the time of application;
- the score awarded for the study curriculum is weighed on the basis of the "Webometrics Ranking of World Universities", proceeding as follows: 3 points for universities in position from 1 to 1000 in the ranking; 2 points for universities in position from 1001 to 2000; 1 point for universities in position from 2001 to 3000 in the ranking; 0 points for universities in position from 3001 onwards;
- the possession of the curricular requirements does not give a score but is an admission prerequisite;
- the certificate of English language proficiency does not give a score but is an admission prerequisite.

CONFIRMATION OF STUDY PLACE AND ENROLMENT

If you have been admitted through the ranking list, you must:

- 1) select the degree course in the Application portal and pay with one of the indicated payment methods to confirm the study place within 17 October 2025, 12 (midday). The first instalment of tuition fees amounts to € 600.00.
- 2) until 17 October 2025, 12 (midday), enrol online in the Application portal.

If you do not respect the deadlines, you will automatically lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

If by paying the 1st instalment you have confirmed the study place, there will be no refund of the tuition fees.

According to national regulations, simultaneous enrolment in a maximum of 2 programmes is possible (however, the two programmes must not belong to the same class, e.g., LM-18/LM-18 and must differ for at least 2/3 of the course activities).

If you have been admitted to more than one study programme, you can confirm your place for a maximum of 2 programmes by paying the designated fee twice.

If you do not have the required academic qualification, you will be given a conditional offer for a study place, and you must submit your qualification upon enrolment. If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you cannot enrol, and you will lose your place which will be offered to the subsequent applicant in the ranking list.

Advice: If you achieve your qualification after the enrolment deadline, you should not pay the tuition fees to confirm the study place. You will be able to submit a late enrolment request and, only if there are study places still available, you can enrol by 12 December 2025.

If you have been admitted in the ranking list, but you do not possess a valid admission qualification, you can be excluded with Rector's decree even after enrolment.

Please note that you do not gain full student status by only paying the tuition fees. This status will only be acquired upon enrolment.

ENROLMENT WITH QUALIFICATIONS GAINED ABROAD

If you have gained your qualification abroad, at enrolment you must upload in the Application portal (if not uploaded upon application):

- the degree diploma of your Bachelor;
- the official translation of your degree into Italian (translation is not necessary if the documents have been issued in German or English);
- the Diploma supplement, where it must be indicated:
 - that you have achieved at least 180 credit points (ECTS) and
 - that the qualification gives access to a Master programme.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in an EU country or in Switzerland, Norway, Iceland, or Liechtenstein, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Correspondence of your Bachelor degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy.

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a non-EU country that is signatory to the Lisbon Convention, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Correspondence of your Bachelor degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy
- the Statement of Verification of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

If you have gained your qualification abroad in a non-EU country that is not signatory to the Lisbon Convention, at enrolment you must also upload:

- the Statement of Comparability of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA)
- the Statement of Verification of your Bachelor degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

Your admission will be under reservation until the above-mentioned documents are uploaded.

During enrolment, unibz verifies your foreign qualification and may request additional documents if necessary.

If the access title is deemed eligible, the reservation will be lifted. Otherwise, enrolment will not be possible and you will be excluded.

Please note: If you have declared to be resident in Italy but have not attached to your application a copy of your valid residence permit for Italy (see article 39, paragraph 5 of decree no. 286 of 25.07.1998) you will be excluded from the ranking list.
