### **CONFIRMATION OF STUDY PLACE**

In order to confirm your position following your successful placement on the ranking list, you must select your PhD programme on the portal at the following link https://aws.unibz.it/exup/ and pay the one-off tuition fee (EUR 200.00) by one of the methods indicated by the following deadline:

• Positions **with scholarship**: from the publication of the ranking list to July 24<sup>th</sup> 2025 (midday) (GMT+2:00)

Failure to meet the above-mentioned deadline will result in the forfeiture of the position.

**Please note:** confirmation of a position through payment of tuition fees does not confer student status. The latter is acquired upon enrolment.

Applicants who confirm their position but do not proceed to enrol are not entitled to a refund of the amount paid. Refunds are only made in the event that the applicant is a non-EU citizen residing abroad and does not obtain the necessary documentation for enrolment from the foreign Italian representation.

Applicants conditionally admitted, due to the lack of the qualification required by the call for applications, must present their qualification at the time of enrolment, under penalty of forfeiting their position, which will be offered to the applicant who follows in the ranking list.

### **ENROLMENT**

After confirming the study place and

Starting from July 25<sup>th</sup> until October 31<sup>st</sup> 2025 at 12:00 (GMT+2:00)

it is necessary to proceed to online enrolment in the application portal.



Failure to meet the aforementioned deadline will result in forfeiture of the position.

# Applicants with foreign qualifications must upload these documents in the portal (if not already uploaded during application):

- degree diploma of the Master
- official translation of the diploma into Italian (not necessary if the documents have been issued in German or English)
- diploma supplement for the Master's degree, indicating that it qualifies for a PhD programme.

If foreign qualifications do not include a diploma supplement, this document does not need to be uploaded.

# Depending on the foreign education system the degree belongs to, the following documents must be uploaded:

- A. EU countries, Switzerland, Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein:
  - <u>Statement of Correspondence of your Master's degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI</u> Automatic Recognition Database Italy
- **B.** Non-EU countries that are signatories to the Lisbon Convention:
  - <u>Statement of Correspondence</u> of your Master's degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI - Automatic Recognition Database – Italy
  - <u>Statement of Verification</u> of your Master's degree, issued by the Italian Information
     Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA)
- **C.** Non-EU countries that are not signatories of the Lisbon Convention:
  - <u>Statement of Comparability</u> of your Master's degree, to be downloaded from the ARDI -Automatic Recognition Database – Italy
  - <u>Statement of Verification</u> of your Master's degree, issued by the Italian Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA)

If the required document is not uploaded by the time of enrolment, the applicant will be enrolled with reservations. The documents must in any case be submitted by **15 January 2026** under penalty of exclusion from the programme.

For a university degree obtained abroad and recognised in Italy, upload a copy of the recognition decree.

Unibz performs the necessary verifications of the foreign qualification and reserves the right to request further documentation to supplement the documentation already submitted. If it emerges, as a result of the aforementioned verifications, that the qualification does not meet the requirements of the present call for applications and therefore does not allow enrolment in the PhD programme, the applicant will be excluded.

### Non-EU citizens residing abroad



Non-EU citizens living abroad must apply on the Universitaly portal of the Ministry of Universities and Research. On Universitaly it is possible to apply for only one study programme. If this procedure is not followed, the online application to unibz will be declared invalid.

Please note that prior admission by unibz does not guarantee obtaining a visa, the issuing of which is the sole responsibility of embassies and consulates. Similarly, obtaining a visa for study purposes does not confer any right to complete enrolment on a PhD programme.

In accordance with the relevant legislation in force, the applicant must apply for a residence permit within 8 working days of entering Italy. Upon arrival, he or she may contact the Unibz Office Study and Tuition, which will provide the necessary information to start the procedure.

Once the residence permit has been obtained, the applicant must submit it in original or send it by email (front/back) to the Student Secretariat.
